Documentation tips for coding hypertensive heart disease:

- List first the combination code for hypertensive heart disease
- Document the causal relationship between the heart disease and HTN (“caused by”, “due to”, etc.)

Documentation tips for coding depression:


- Document the severity (mild, moderate, etc.)
- Document the episode
- Document the status of the episode

 Documentation tips for coding neoplasms: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only use the term “history of” when the neoplasm no longer exists • Document if the neoplasm is benign, in situ, malignant, or of uncertain behavior.

Malignant neoplasm, prostate	C61

Chronic hepatitis C without hepatic coma	B18.2
Factors Influencing Health Status	
 Documentation tips for health status: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Don't forget to document/code for artificial openings annually (more if needed for complications, cleanings, etc.) if applicable • BMI should be recorded anytime the height and weight is taken and coded if it affects the patient's condition (underweight, overweight, obese, etc.)

Other artificial openings status	Z93.8
Ileostomy status	Z93.2
Lower limb amputation other toe, UNSP	Z89.429-
Lower limb amputation, below knee	Z89.519
Body mass index	Z68.20 to Z68.--
