ALARMING STATISTICS

Each year, prescription drug overdoses:

- Kill more than 16,000 Americans¹
- Result in 1.2 million visits to an emergency room²

From 2006 to 2016, diagnoses for opioid use disorder spiked by almost five-fold³

Deaths due to opioids:3

- More than doubled between 2006 and 2016
- Increased another 16 percent between 2016 and 2017

- Helps eliminate waste from the healthcare system by reducing multiple doctor and ER visits, duplicative testing, and overlapping therapies

What the ECSU program monitors

- Number of doctors visited and pharmacies used
- Distance traveled to physician or pharmacy
- Frequency of prescriptions
- Geography and patient population
- Mix of drugs dispensed

How this differs from the past

- Our enhanced program casts a wider net by increasing what is monitored, including distance traveled to providers or pharmacies and geography.
- This enhanced program uses advanced analytics and full investigative services to identify customers needing greater oversight by their healthcare team.
- The investigative team at Express Scripts monitors patient and prescriber patterns to identify situations of abnormal use or prescribing. If a member is identified, the team looks for abusive or fraudulent patterns and examines risk scenarios for patient and presciber intervention.
