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Coverage of any service is determined by a member's eligibility, benefit limits for the service or services rendered and the application of the Plan's Medical Policy. Final payment is subject to the application of claims adjudication edits common to the industry and the **Plan's professional or facility services claims coding policies**. Reimbursement is restricted to the provider's scope of practice as well as the fee schedule applicable to that provider.

Purpose	To define when the Plan recognizes and reimburses services appended with Modifier SL that are submitted on a CMS 1500 paper claim or 837P electronic claim form.			
Scope	Applies to all Premera Blue Cross, Premera Blue Cross Blue Shield of Alaska, LifeWise Health Plan of Washington, LifeWise Assurance Company, and Premera Blue Cross HMO lines of business and products.			
Policy	The Plan recognizes modifier SL to indicate that a vaccine was obtained at no cost to the provider. Therefore, a vaccine code billed with modifier SL will not be reimbursed. The procedure code(s) representing the administration of the vaccines will be reimbursed. Modifier SL is not appropriate to be appended to a vaccine administration code and will be denied as incorrect coding. Per Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) coding guidelines, administration procedure codes 90460 and 90461 include face-to-face counseling of the patient/family/guardian during the administration of the vaccine and administration procedure codes 90471-90474 do not include a face-to-face counseling to the patient/family/guardian. Vaccine administration codes 90460-90461 and 90471-90474 should not be reported with severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus (SARS-CoV2) vaccine procedure codes 91304, and 91318-91322. These SARS-CoV2 vaccine procedure codes (91304, 91318-91322) are reported with administration procedure code 90480.			

Codes/Coding Guidelines	Vaccine administration codes include the following:		
Guidelines	 90460 – Immunization administration through 18 years of age via any route of administration, with counseling by physician or other qualified health care professional; first or only component of each vaccine or toxoid administered +90461 – Immunization administration through 18 years of age via any route of administration, with counseling by physician or other qualified health care professional; each additional vaccine or toxoid component administered (List separately in addition to code for primary procedure) Report 90461 in conjunction with code 90460 for each additional component of a given vaccine 90471 – Immunization administration (includes percutaneous, intradermal, subcutaneous, or intramuscular injections); 1 vaccine (single or combination vaccine/toxoid)		
Violations of Policy	Violations of this policy by any party that enters into a written arrangement with the Plan may result in increased auditing and monitoring, performance guarantee contractual penalties and/or termination of the contract.
